- ➤ F) Motion made by Shannon Parsons, seconded by Bill Knowlton and carried to approve Project #2012-70-102, Garage Addition, Div. 9, Lot 40, 5740 Nakat Way, Jake Eigenbrood subject that the garage is 20 feet long, 9 feet wide, and 11 feet 6 inches tall at the roof peak; is installed at the back of the house behind the current garage; and the siding matches the house (all other specifics per the submitted plans and checklist).

DISCUSSION:

- Ken Woods brought up the terms expiring in November: Richard Baer, Jim Baker, Carl Garlow, and Shannon Parsons are all ending their first term. Ken Woods is currently on a second term extension. Shannon Parsons will not be running a second term. - The office will look into different ways of getting the word out that volunteers are needed to serve on ACC and other committees.
- Ken Hoffer brought up the status on a few non-compliant structures. Two playground sets built without approval will have some applications for the next ACC meeting; the owner with the archway/trellis being erected on Salish Road was contacted and work has ceased the owner has agreed to remove the trellis as it is in the 25 foot setback and does not conform to the AR&Rs.
- Shannon Parsons reminded everyone to re-read the AR&Rs 1.3 stating that *all* structures, including replacement projects, need approval by the ACC unless otherwise stated elsewhere in the AR&Rs.
