

**BBVCC Lakes Committee Minutes**  
**March 6, 2013**

**Present:** Committee members Gary Levy, Ken Hecker, Bernd Werny; Gen. Mgr. Ken Hoffer and Board Liaison Jim Lockie; ; Adam Klevin of AquaTechnex; Ueli Nussbaum, Larry Eide.

Minutes of last October's Meeting were approved. A quorum was present.

1. Hoffer will follow up with Annette Hoffman of WDFW as to whether the application filed last fall is still good or whether we need to re-file it in April. WDFW is considering our proposal to stage carp introduction over the five years rather than stocking all at once. Hoffer will also ask if permits are required for tilapia introduction.
2. The committee discussed the 2013 chemical applications program for the lakes and reviewed the AquaTechnex proposal with Mr Klevin. The program to be implemented will be similar to last year, with a Sonar treatment in mid-May followed by a second treatment 3-4 weeks later. Granular copper or liquid may be applied for algae control if necessary. Village staff will apply dye treatments and calcium chloride as last year.
3. Ueli Nussbaum reported that he had ordered rebuild kits for the aeration compressors, but that he would wait for signs of trouble before commencing the maintenance.
4. Larry Eide's application for Lakes Committee membership was approved subject to Board action. Hoffer noted that Gene Carr was not on the committee mailing list. His address will be added.
5. The committee discussed possible means of nightshade eradication. Hoffer pointed out that the species present in the village is one of the less toxic varieties. Private property issues and the dispersed nature of the plant make would complicate a village-wide chemical eradication program.
