

**BBVCC Lakes Committee Minutes**  
**April 3, 2013**

**Present:** Committee members Gary Levy, Ken Hecker, Rick Whitaker, Larry Eide; Gen. Mgr. Ken Hoffer and Board Liaison Jim Lockie; ; Ueli Nussbaum.

Minutes of last October's Meeting were approved. A quorum was present.

- 1.** Hoffer reported that the WDFW has indicated an approval document is coming for grass carp stocking. They will not approve carp introduction spread over the five years, but we do have 12 months to introduce the fish. That means we can spread it over two fiscal years. The number of fish we are allowed is not yet known. If it is the same as last time we will ask for more.
- 2.** AquaTechnex will apply the first Sonar treatment in mid-May. We are short some calcium chloride, which will be ordered, along with some Aqua-shade dye. Hoffer reported that BBV staff also uses the dye for non-lakes purposes.
- 3.** Ueli Nussbaum reported that the compressors were functioning, but that we have some bad bubblers, particularly in Thunderbird and the golf course ponds. Hecker and Whitaker will check that and clean them as necessary. Whitaker reported minimal turbidity in Thunderbird as indicated by Secchi Disk test. Kwann also appears good as do the ponds, except for some cloudiness in the north golf course pond.
- 4.** Hoffer reported that Dave Vinke (the trapper) would be removing muskrats, which have apparently become numerous. Hoffer will make sure that Vinke has modified his trapping technique to eliminate the carp kill experienced last year.
