Meeting Called to order 7pm

Minutes from May 6th were discussed. There were several minor changes that Ken Hoffer will revise and keep on file.

Carp Update:

All agreed the fish are "doing their job". Sightings indicate the fish have adapted well and are growing quite large. The current permit is for the Ponds. The next time to add carp into the lakes is 2019, based on the 5 year policy.

Chemical Applications Update:

Ken Hoffer sent out an updated Lakes Management Log. On May 7th Sonar treatment and algaecide were completed. On May 15th, CaCl and on the 18th, Dye.
As of this week the pronounced algae in Thunderbird has been treated and is now back under control.

Lake/Pond Condition

Overall, the conditions look good given the water levels and warmer climate this year. Rick's latest temperature readings for Kwan was 71 degrees, Thunderbird 72 degrees
Larry indicated he has seen some type of "little white threads" of algae, on Kwan Lake. Not sure what this is, so we will monitor and determine a course of action if it continues.

Aeration Compressors Status:

Right now they all appear to be functioning ok. Ueli had expressed some concern as to the amount of "life expectancy" left on some of the units. Ken will order up 1 (220) and 2 (110) units so we can have them on hand should a unit or two should shut down and can not be repaired. We have 4 x 220 and 10 x 110 units total
