Carp Update:

150 Grass Carp were delivered and put into the two lakes. Each lake received about 75 each. The plan is to receive another 250 in the spring of 2014. 150 to split between the two lakes, maybe 100 for the larger golf course ponds, and if there is enough funding, adding another 200-250 split between the two lakes in April/May 2014.

Chemical Applications:

Mid May the Sonar treatment was done, CACL is being applied over a 10 week cycle.

Lake/Pond Conditions

So far water looks pretty clear, with some nightshade beginning to pop up. A discussion of possible actions included: having some volunteers get out and pull the stuff, chemical applications if possible (pretty difficult per codes). Either way we would need home owner authorization to approach their banks via to remove the nightshade

Gene Carr and Ken Hecker went out into Thunderbird and repaired the unit that was not working.

Miscellaneous Lake Business:

Mosquitos: It was discussed that it has been many years since there were any mosquito issues. The question came up regarding what options we have to limit/prevent mosquito infestation. Ken Hecker indicated that we have tons of stickleback fish in both lakes, and they appear to be a primary reason we don't have issues at this time. All agreed that we need to make sure we keep a lookout for those pesky devils and make sure we don't allow them to gain a foothold in our part of paradise.

It was pointed out once again, that if the golf course is going to "dredge" any of the ponds this year, we seriously would like to be notified so we can make sure they don't kill any fish we have in the ponds
