

Minutes - Roads and Drainage Committee Meeting – August 10, 2017

1. The Quinault Cul-de-sac owners are obtaining a contractor to draft up plans for correcting the drainage problem. Due to submit to ACC on September 5, 2017. Once the plans are approved by Roads and Drainage (R&D), ACC will review.
2. The R&D staff will stop volunteering to install mailboxes once the backlog of 28 requests is completed. Backlog work is expected to continue into September. New requests will be put on a waiting list by the office and the office will no longer collect funds until further notice. Harry Shearer will continue installing new mailboxes for new homes as previous. The notice about moving mailboxes will remain on the Main Gate board until further notice.
3. Replacement of four major culverts is complete. Two remaining culverts have been contracted to Iverson and work will begin soon. The Salish/Sehome project will begin after school starts to reduce impact on traffic. The greenbelt effort will be first. Paving of the roads will begin soon.
4. Three ditch connections on Tsawwassen Loop still need to be completed. R&D volunteers have been depleted. Attention to R&D will be redirected after the mailbox efforts are completed
5. Twenty-three set of building plans were approved by Roads and Drainage.
6. Recruiting for the R&D committee is still ongoing. New members are needed.
7. A complaint of someone dumping gasoline in a village drain was noted on bulletin website Next Door. A request for a name or address was requested but no response has been received.
