

Road & Drainage meeting minutes- October 8<sup>th</sup> 2015.

Meeting started at 10:00am

Risers on Quinault road were discussed. These are the small round ones for water shut off, Birch Bay Water & Sewer will take care of – no time line as of now.

Road striping is done; the stencil work & lane dividers will be put in when weather permits.

There will be a winter time break for meeting unless anything urgent comes up, next meeting will be in February of 2016.

The progress of the sewer lids was discussed: more than half the work is done and it is looking great. There was a discussion of a sewer lid that is a little low and sideways that may need to be done as well.

It was brought up that there are a few areas in the village that the shoulder is higher than the road; the issue is the storm water runs down the road for several feet before finding a low spot. Steve Freitas will contact a few contractors to see if they would be interested in grading the roadsides.

There was a list of open gaps that are between culverts that the committee has decided to fill with scrap pieces of pipe. The list is attached to the agenda, locates will be ordered before each job is started.
