

BIRCH BAY VILLAGE COMMUNITY CLUB
POLICY RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
ON SPEEDING ON THE ROADS WITHIN
BIRCH BAY VILLAGE

This policy resolution, duly adopted by the Board of Directors of Birch Bay Village Community Club on the 24 day of August, 1989, sets forth the general rules of the club concerning use of the roadways within the confines of Birch Bay Village and further, sets forth limitations and penalties which may be imposed by the Board for violation of rules and policies concerning use of said roadways:

1. The speed limit on all roads within Birch Bay Village is limited to 20 mph (Basic Speed Limit).
2. In the event that any person violates the Basic Speed Limit such person is subject to being cited for such violation.
3. After issuance of a citation, the Board of Directors of Birch Bay Village Community Club, may, at it's discretion, call for the attendance of an offending driver at a meeting of the Birch Bay Village Board of Directors at which time the Board may inquire concerning the circumstances of the violation and may impose such sanction as in the Board's view is appropriate including imposition of fines..
4. Any person having received three (3) citations for violation of the Basic Speed Limit in Birch Bay Village shall be required to appear before the Board of Directors of Birch Bay Village Community Club at which time the Board may inquire concerning the circumstances of the violations. The Board may impose such sanction as in the Board's view is appropriate including imposition of fines.
5. Any person receiving four (4) citations for violating the Basic Speed Limit within a one (1) year period shall have the privilege of driving on the roads of Birch Bay Village suspended for a period of not less than thirty (30) days and not more than six (6) months.
6. In the event that the Board, after giving a violator an opportunity to explain his or her actions,

determines that it is in the best interests of the Village that a sanction be imposed, then the Board shall cause the resident to be informed of such decision in writing following the meeting of the Board of Directors at which such property owner was given an opportunity to comment on the violation.

7. Nothing within this policy shall be deemed to limit the discretion of the Board in ordering a suspension of the privilege of driving on the roads of Birch Bay Village prior to a violator accumulating four (4) citations, it being the policy of the Board that in the event that four (4) citations are accumulated a suspension of the privilege shall be mandatory.

8. Failure to pay a monetary fine imposed by the Board within seven (7) days shall result in the suspension of the privilege of driving on the roads of Birch Bay Village for a period of thirty (30) days for each fine unpaid.
