#### 4. Greens Keeper Report: Steve Brand

- #6/15 work continues. New Bunker behind #15 then change #6&15 greenies
- Picking up a lot of stuff from the clean up around the course. Thanks you Volunteers
- Mowing for Whatcom Seniors
- Cart path work will continue after #15 work is done
- Drainage on #7 fairway. Easier to do with ponds lower now
- Asked landscaping folks to look at #9 tee box (right side) for blackberries
- Irrigation is ready; will run when it dries out a little
- Steve F asked about the ball marks on greens and if we can do something to improve golfers doing this; some kind of recognition of good golfers; include a topic in the Golf Club spring meeting (Bill Duncan). Acknowledged that this is a chronic problem

#### 5. <u>Rec Center Report</u>: Krista Templeton

- Incidents on the Course: Are the forms helping?
  - There was an issue with junior golfers sharing golf clubs (Krista could have fixed it if Leanne reported it in person)
  - Sometimes making adjustments to policy per Rec Center Manager's discretion are OK (e.g. 4 people with 3 sets of clubs, a fivesome, etc.)

#### Simulator: What's the plan?

- It has been taken down and will be stored for spring/summer months.
- Where to put next Fall? Is it possible to close in the outside covered area of the clubhouse to house the simulator in fall/winter months?
- Prepare an estimate for the enclosure in time for the Village Budget process approval. Talk with Buildings and Lands about this idea

#### • Staffing Plans? Hours of Operation?

- 7 days/week from 9am to 5pm
- New golf attendant in July. Ryan- over 21 yrs. old

When need Volunteers to Marshall or Grill? What about the Grill

- People have volunteered to do marshaling after hours. Bob O will send the rules to everyone for review so we can get folks going. Marshals just need to record an incident for violators.
- Volunteers not necessary for grilling.
- $\circ$  Put a sign at the 8<sup>th</sup> tee box to encourage grill purchases before arriving at Rec Center.
- Update for Sponsored Golfers Reward approved by BOD. They will decide how to issue it.
- YTD Financials for Golf will be reviewed in April for 1<sup>st</sup> quarter
- Details for the North Bay Tournament
  - July 22<sup>nd</sup> was approved unanimously by the Committee

#### • Marketing Golf:

- The Village is going to promote outside Tournaments of up to 12. We still have to approve the Tournament. The Village assumes the liability. Really the same policy already in place for people wanting to have a private Tournament.
- Promotions to play during slow times on the course, including all non-busy times (Monday morning, Thursday afternoon, Friday morning, others?)
- Schedule and offer a New Golfer Clinic to encourage new residents to golf
- Schedule an Open House for non-tournament Saturday in May or June. Could be morning and afternoon event with easy tournament, walk around course playing some kind of game? We all will begin to prepare thoughts and share with the Committee

#### • Anything else?

- Repair of the Hitting Cage floor Bobbi and maintenance need to work on this
- Feeding the Birds especially on #2 Fairway
  - Elizabeth W proposed some deterrent devices (pepper, streamers, fake snakes) to scare off the birds
  - BOD to look into this matter and notify homeowner
  - Real Estate Agents have commented on the negative appearance to the fairway.
