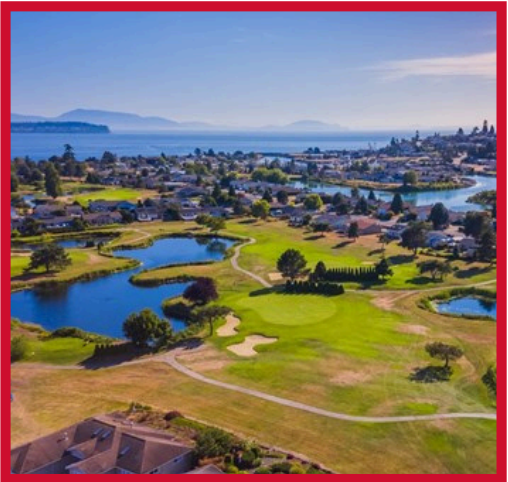
- 1 **Fills Gaps in Services** - Volunteers help provide resources that might otherwise be unavailable.
